Electoral Roll – Notice of Renewal

This year all Anglican churches in England are required to undertake a complete renewal of their electoral rolls. All names on the existing roll are removed and everyone who wishes to be included in the new Jesus Church Roll must complete a form to register. We are planning to get the main process underway on Sundays 10th, 17th and 24th March but forms will be available for completion in the Charis at anytime before then and when completed can be placed in the box file provided. The closing date for this revision is Wednesday 3rd April. If you have never been on the roll before and would like to do so now the eligibility criteria for being registered appears on the forms.
