One of the most striking passages in the Old Testament that Jesus fulfilled is the suffering servant song in Isaiah. It starts with God's wisdom being revealed (Is 52:13-15) and then the witnesses explore who has believed the message and the significance of the message including the suffering servant being punished for the sins of other to bring them healing(53:-1-6). Then a lone witness develops the theme which is quoted in our reading this morning (53:7-19) The final part gives God's view of the suffering and forgiveness that flowed from his actions.
