In the morning we looked at the fourth sign that is recorded in John's gospel. Jesus wanted to provide food for the enormous crowd of 5000 men plus women and children that had come out to see Him. He asked Philip where shall we buy bread and Philip responded by saying it would cost more than 8 months wages. A boy offered his packed lunch of 5 loaves and 2 small fish. Jesus gave thanks and there was enough food for everyone. This time an enormous community was fed. Jesus expected people to play their part, the disciple Philip was asked a question, but failed to respond in faith. A small amount of food was brought by Andrew from a boy and the miracle happened. Are we willing to grow in our faith and expectancy, willing to use what we have in God's service?
